

FIELD RULES

ALL PLAYERS MUST ATTEND THE SAFETY MEETING.

GOGGLES

Approved safety goggles must be worn at all times while playing/observing or near any paintball activity or chrono areas. Goggles should be worn at any time a game is in progress or you see someone without a barrel cover. The referees will notify players when it is safe to remove their goggles. Never remove your goggles during a paintball activity or while on the field. Call for a referee if you have concerns with your goggles.

BARREL COVERS

Use a barrel cover at all times. Removal of your barrel cover is only permitted in the chrono area or on the playing field while wearing goggles. When you are eliminated from a game, immediately cover your barrel before leaving the playing field.

SPORTSMANSHIP

Good sportsmanship is expected at all times. Follow instructions given by referees or field staff. Do not argue with other players or the referees. Profanity is not permitted at the Church Field. Verbal abuse, arguing, or physical contact will not be tolerated. Confrontational behavior is completely unacceptable. Any player engaging in verbal or physical abuse of another player, referee, staff, volunteer, or representative will be removed from the field and the authorities will be contacted.

All players must be wearing a wristband to participate in paintball activities. If you are caught without a wristband on your arm, you will be escorted to Registration, required to complete waivers and to purchase a wristband or else be asked to leave.

ELIMINATION

When a paintball hits and breaks on a player and/or his equipment, the player is eliminated from the game (called "out"). Sometimes the paintball will not break ("bounce") allowing him to continue to play. If the player is unsure, he should call a referee over for a "paint check." Wiping paint off from a broken paintball is considered cheating and not permitted. If a player raises his hand or marker, or calls himself out, then he is considered to be out. He may not change his mind. Once declared "out", keep your goggles on, and immediately cover your barrel and leave the field. Never remove your goggles until you are outside of the playing field.

Leave the field quietly, do not talk to any other players. Do not give other players your unused paintballs or other equipment as you leave. Exit the field at the designated entry way. Do not crawl under a side net to exit the field. Persons observing the game from outside the nets may not communicate with any of the game participants.

BUNKERS

Bunkering (rushing up on a bunker occupied by an opponent) is not allowed. Players must shoot from another bunker or a distance of at least 20 feet away. If a player has flanked an opponent, good sportsmanship would be to ask him to surrender without firing. If the opponent does not want to surrender, the attacker must not over-shoot him (no more than 3 shots).

Firing "blindly" is not allowed. Have your marker in front of your face so that you present a target while shooting, as other players present targets to you. Do not move or climb upon any field objects, walls, nets, vegetation, or bunkers. Do not shoot at wildlife found on or near the field.

SPEED & MODE

Your marker must be checked for paintball velocity several times during the day. Dry firing is only permitted in the chrono area or at the air smith's station; not in the parking lot. All markers must have a chrono speed under 280 fps. Semi-auto is the only firing mode allowed at this field; thus, one shot per trigger pull only. Full auto, turbos, ramping, or multi-round bursts will not be tolerated.

PARKING LOT

By backing your vehicle up to the curb, you will be able to handle paintballs over the dirt. Before you leave, clean up any paintball mess on the pavement and put your garbage into a black trash can. Please, leave our parking lot as clean as you found it. Thanks!

I, _____ **HEREBY AGREE AS FOLLOWS:**

1. I hereby certify that I do not suffer from any physical infirmities, chronic illnesses, or physical disabilities which are effected by or prohibit me from engaging and participating in the sport of paintball.

I understand and acknowledge that the sport of paintball under certain circumstances may be an inherently dangerous activity that can result in the loss of life, eyesight, hearing, or a serious injury even to those who have experience in the sport. I also understand and acknowledge that there is a chance of being injured by running into props, trees, other players and undesirable vegetation or natural wildlife as a result of playing outdoors. I expressly and voluntarily assume the above risks while participating in or observing paintball activities.
3. I agree to obey all safety and game rules and assume full responsibility for my actions.
4. I understand that if I am under the age of 18 I will need legal guardian consent to participate in paintball.
5. I release and discharge the owners of the property and/or Spring of Life Christian Church and/or any of its staff, volunteers or representatives from any and all liability, claims, demands or causes of actions that I may hereafter have for injuries and other damages or losses arising out of my participation in or observation of the sport of paintball and all activities related.
6. I will not sue or make claim against the owners of the property and/or Spring of Life Christian Church and/or any of its staff, volunteers or representatives from any and all liability, claims, demands or causes of actions that I may hereafter have for injuries and other damages or losses arising out of my participation in or observation of the sport of paintball and all activities related. I also agree to indemnify and hold the owners of the property and/or Spring of Life Christian Church and/or any of its staff, volunteers or representatives harmless from all claims, judgments, costs, including attorney fees, incurred in connection with any action brought as a result of my participation in or observation of the sport of paintball and all activities related.
7. I understand that I am required to wear a mask at all times playing and/or observing any paintball activity.
8. I have fully and carefully read this waiver of liability agreement, and I fully understand all its contents and sign it of my own free will for the purposes set forth herein.
